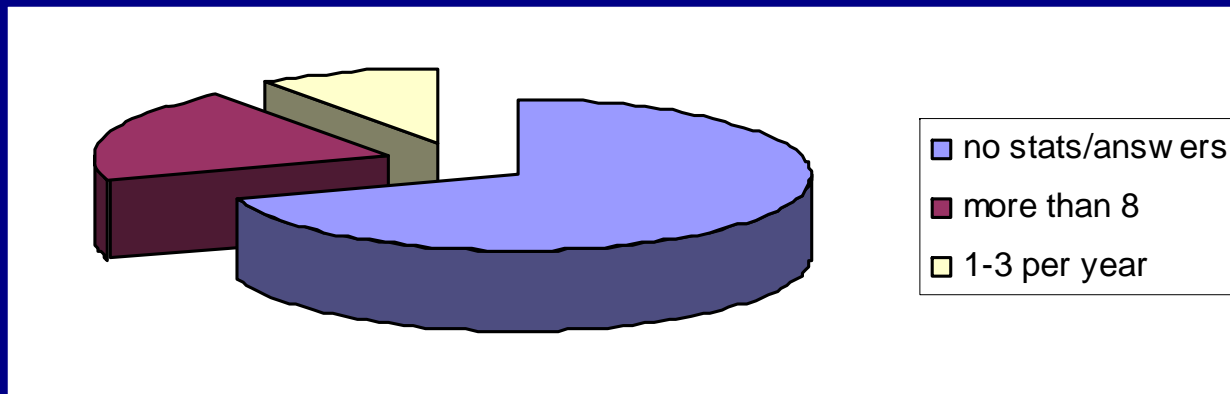
Interviews were conducted among professionals in the field of drug abuse

100 % of participants stated that they have encountered female cases where inter-relationship between drug abuse and sexual abuse was evident

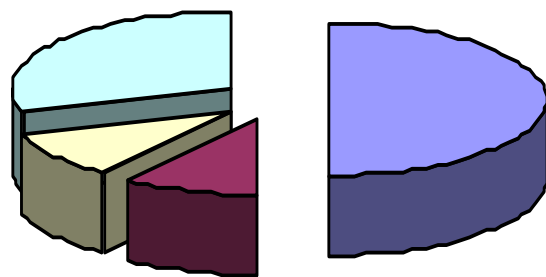
70% of professionals were informed of the sexual abuse by the victim

Statistics recording number and frequency of cases encountered by professionals

- 70% - No statistics kept / no answer
- 20% - Encountered more than 8
 - 10% - Between 1 and 3



Original incidence of sexual abuse in cases encountered by professionals

■ no answer

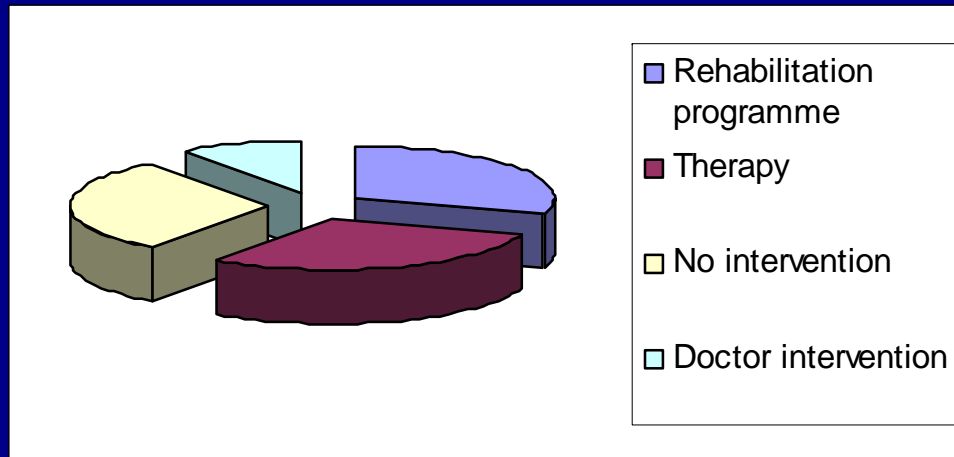
- 50% abuse in childhood
- 10% abuse in adolescence
- 10% in adulthood
- 30% gave no indication

Cases of sex trading or prostitution in female drug addicts

- **80% of cases at some point traded sex for drugs/ prostitution**

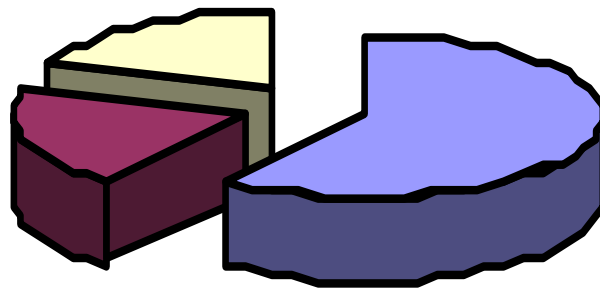
Type of help provided to the client for sexual abuse

- Rehabilitation programme -30%
 - Therapy – 30%
 - No intervention – 30%
 - Doctor intervention – 10%



Outcomes of help provided

- Positive outcome – 60%
- Not assessed yet – 20%
- No answer – 20%

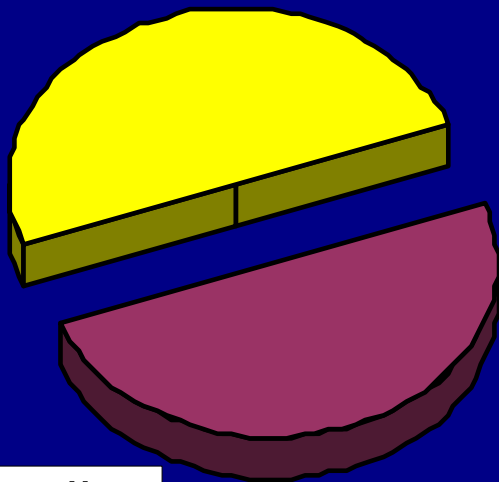
